Dear Senator Harris:

I am concerned about privacy. FISA reauthorization has just been backed by the House leaving only the Senate and your Homeland Security committee to increase accountability. The irresponsibility of this administration was highlighted a few weeks ago when then acting secretary of the DHS asserted authority to forward DACA information to ICE. The willingness of my government to collect whatever data it can find was highlighted by the revelations of Snowden a few years ago. Today intimate details of people's lives are left open to anyone with the resources hack it. Whether information is gathered by our spy agencies or like DACA simply by lying about its intended use there needs to be thoughtful statutory regulation with judicial oversight. Our privacy is too important to leave to the whim of this unpredictable administration.
