Dear Mr. Attorney General:

I am concerned about illegal ICE activity. Immigration and Customs Enforcement agents appear to be illegally using racial profiling and stopping people without reasonable suspicion of any crime. This criminal activity by ICE agents seems likely to be either the result of little oversight or else pressure to meet quotas rather than follow the law. Lawsuits have been filed against agents in Virginia and New Mexico and those illegally detained who have lawyers are arguing in immigration courts for dismissals. There are also many stories of ICE agents acting completely arbitrarily. For instance this past weekend at a circle-K in Atwater during a broad sweep agents reportedly stopped a group of four people, demanded documents, arrested three and deported two. These profiling crimes should be prosecuted and everyone should have access to lawyers.

*Please assure me that you will prosecute illegal ICE profiling.*

I am very proud to be a California resident and a large part of that derives from the rule of law.
