Dear Senator Feinstein:

I am concerned about Russian involvement in US governance. Stories and FBI investigation of connections between Russian operatives and the current US President predate his election and his moves to dismantle western alliances and ignore Russian expansionism suggest a continuing obedience. Both the FBI and special prosecutor investigated - the House not so much - but as the corruption of the Justice Department has grown from General Barr's initial attempts to stifle Mr Mueller's report to the more recent moves to drop charges against Mr Flynn the need for a bipartisan report not under the President's thumb has as well. Very few times in the past decade have elected Republicans acted with integrity and eleven weeks before an election such moves are particularly rare.

Thank you for ushering a bipartisan report out of the Intelligence Committee.

I am very proud to be a US resident and a large part of that derives from our honest government.
