Dear Mr President:

I am concerned about genocide.

You bear significant responsibility for the starvation in Gaza and are morally obliged to act. You have provided more financial, military and political support for Prime Minister Netanyahu than any other entity with billions in military aid expedited and a call to expel Palestinians just this year. Last month many congressional Democrats have finally called out the horror of the food blockade and the cynical plan to use aid for military ends. The plan continues to have your administration's support while Republicans continue their silence.
