The supreme court in an unsigned emergency order has just allowed your government to attack and expell half million people now protected from deportation to Cuba, Haiti, Nicaragua, and Venezuela by four CHNV programs with US government promises of at least another year of stability. Most of these people were invited to settle here by the same federal government now persecuting them and the courts are still deciding whether Secretary Noem's sweeping order to end their protected status was legal 'rendering constraints of law irrelevant' to quote Justice Jackson's dissent. With ICE targeting whoever they happen to come across as in the case yesterday of Mr Da Silva - a Milford MA high school student snatched from his car by a unit with a quota to meet - the threat to those newly exposed to deportation is real.

Please assure me that you will stop ICE arrests of humanitarian parolees. My pride in the US derives in part from government consistency.
