Dear Mr President:

I am concerned about justice.

The International Criminal Court is the court of last resort for those targeted with war crimes or genocide. Previously several special courts convened to prosecute specific such acts but the process was less predictable and hence less likely to deter than the permanently constituted body. The US has provided only tepid and transactional support when the prosecutions aligned with Washington's political goals making the world safer for those terrorizing civilian populations. You have taken this resistance even further with today's personal sanctions against four members of the court. Undermining the ICC speaks to the need for such a body as you have apparently decided that the cases against your proxies indefensible.

*Please assure me that you will support the International Criminal Court.* ■
