

**These Are My Suggestions For You
As
Calculus Students In Math 16C**

1. Develop an effective and time-efficient homework/study strategy for this class and others.
2. Find at least one or two other students from this class with whom you can regularly do homework and prepare for exams.
3. Expect to spend up to two to four hours per homework assignment.
4. Begin preparing/outlining/organizing for exams at least five class days before each exam. Use unassigned homework problems, review exercises from the book, and practice exams as sources of new problems.
5. Expect the exams to be challenging.
6. Use all resources available to you, including homework solutions, lecture notes, your classmates, the Calculus Room, my office hours, etc.
7. MATH 16C RELIES HEAVILY ON THE MATERIAL FROM MATH 16A AND MATH 16B. THIS COURSE MOVES ALONG AT A RAPID RATE. IT WILL BE YOUR RESPONSIBILITY TO REVIEW AND RE-LEARN AND FIND ASSISTANCE FOR THOSE ITEMS OR CONCEPTS FROM MATH 16A AND MATH 16B WHICH YOU MAY HAVE FORGOTTEN.
