

Lakes list (Sequoia-Kings central section) of the Sierra Lakes Aquatic Club

This is the official SLAC Lakes list for the Sequoia-Kings central section. Please refer to additional publications for the northern and southern section lists.

To consider a lake visited a member must do five or more of the following in, at, on or from the lake: take a swim; camp for a night; have a drink; eat lunch and gaze at the view; catch, cook and eat a fish; watch a frog; paddle a boat; walk across (we recommend frozen lakes only); play a musical instrument; skim a stone (five or more skips required); gaze upon the reflection; spot a shooting star; identify a constellation; take several photographs, composing each with care; play poohsticks from a bridge crossing the outlet; have a nap; key out a flower; do a cartwheel; enjoy the company and conversation of a good friend; whistle a happy tune; walk right around; admire, but steadfastly refuse to climb, a nearby peak; pick blueberries; cook and eat a gourmet dinner; setup and play on a SLAC line; read a book; or simply while away several hours in peaceful nothingness. No more than two lakes may be considered visited in a single day. In case of doubts or questions of interpretations of the rules, let the spirit of leisure and SLAC prevail.
