Re: Mathematics Placement Requirement (MPR)

All students enrolling in Math 16A are required to satisfy the Mathematics Placement Requirement. The MPR can be satisfied by meeting either one of the following guidelines:

- Passing the Precalculus Diagnostic Exam with an overall score of at least 30 AND a trig score of at least 2.
- Passing MAT 12 (or an equivalent elsewhere) with a C- or better.
- Scoring either a 4 or 5 on the Advanced Placement "AB" Exam.
- Scoring either a 3, 4, or 5 on the Advanced Placement "BC" Exam.
- Score of 700 or above on the Mathematics section of the SAT Reasoning Test.
- Score of 700 or above on the SAT Mathematical Subject tests (Level 1 or Level 2).

Please summarize this information on your syllabus AND mention it to your students on at least two occasions (if possible) before **Saturday, April 4, 2009**.

Please stress to your students that all students who have not met the Mathematics Placement Requirement will be **ADMINISTRATIVELY DROPPED** from the class by the Math Department no matter what anyone else, including an adviser or instructor, may have told them. This action will occur on or before **Tuesday, April 14, 2009**.

If students have taken Math 12 in any quarter prior to **Spring 2009**, they must notify Student Services Office with that information. If they have earned any one of the AP or SAT scores noted above, they must notify Student Services Office of this as well so that we may confirm this with the Registrar.
