

Minor in Mathematics

A minor in the Department of Mathematics consists of completing **20 units of upper division mathematics courses** (excluding MAT 192, 197TC, 198, and 199).

Please note that **you must also complete all prerequisite courses** for the upper division courses you plan to take.

- To complete a minor, you must have a grade point average of 2.0 in all courses required for the minor.
- At most, one course used in satisfaction of your minor may be applied to your major. If you elect more than one minor, these minors may not have any courses in common.
- To have a minor certified on your transcript, you must submit a "Minor Declaration" form in OASIS before the deadline to file for graduation. After you submit this form, it will be sent to the Math Department for approval, as well as your major department and your College Dean's Office.
- Requirements for the minor must be completed by the time of graduation.
- The minor must be outside the department or program of your major. (i.e. a student majoring in Applied Math could not also minor in Math).
