Dear Senator Harris:

The estimated half million new international refugees add to what was already the largest refugee crisis since the world wars. These attacks must be condemned in the strongest terms. Too often the response to such crises has been tragically slow as with the horrors in Syria, Serbia and Rawanda. Responses could include condemnation, sanctions and military actions either by the US or the UN as well as aid and resettlement programs for the Rohingya.
