Besides being intuitively obvious, studies have demonstrated that reducing access to guns reduces deaths. Sadly, congress and the courts have mostly been expanding gun access and working to keep our heads in the sand by restricting access to studies of gun violence. The latest move is HB 38 which will bring concealed weapons to every state of the country. This will make my life and neighborhood less safe.
