I am concerned about nationalism and plutocracy. The Republican party is using its slight majority to tear our egalitarian democracy apart. Democracy is under attack through gerrymandering and voter ID laws as well as the Citizens United case and dark money. One reflection of this can be seen in this weeks budget reconciliation bill. The measure was not popular among voters, but provided direct graft to the president and some members of congress and a path to lucrative lobbying work for those who might be voted out. Both of these are creating an ever more tiered society with increases in poverty and extreme poverty as well as fear and frustration in many communities.
