Dear Senator Harris:

I am concerned about DACA. The appalling attacks on our society by the Immigration and Customs Enforcement agency must be stopped. The litany of abuses is long with illegal profiling, indefinite detentions without appeal, children separated from their parents, arrests in court houses and schools along with minimal oversight. Our million childhood arrivals are a particularly grotesque example of bigotry. There have been many promises made and broken... by the president and by congress members. At this point only a temporary court decision is preventing wholesale deportation of DACA recipients, a process that will likely be expedited by information provided to the DACA program. There are reports that the omnibus budget bill expected to pass this week will be the last major bill of the session making it the last point of leverage. Even the abhorrent Koch brothers are now urging action. Now is the time to defend our principles.

*Please assure me that you will oppose any spending bill without DACA protections.*
