Dear Mr President,

I am concerned about human rights. Someone is now dying in ICE custody every month. People are being held in private, poorly regulated prisons with abusive conditions including poor access to attorneys or parole, maggot-infested food, sexual abuse, unpaid (slave) labor and extensive solitary confinement, all documented at both the Stewart and Elisabeth facilities. This coupled with a policy of separating families is leading to suicides. Marcos Munoz killed himself on May 13 after being forcibly separated from his young child. Jean Jimnez-Joseph killed himself on May 14 after nearly three weeks in solitary confinement. Shockingly, rather than working to regulate these facilities or keep families together, ICE has asked NARA to simply destroy the records. As Auschwitz survivor Bernard Marks explained to Acting Director Homan in March: 'History is not on your side'.

Please assure me that you will end ICE detentions.

I am very proud to be a US resident and a large part of that derives from the bill of rights.
