Dear Mr President:

I am concerned about Brexit. Your support for the UK to leave the EU has been enthusiastic for the past two years. This has an unfortunate appearance partly because it coincides with the time frame in which Putin is known to have been secretly supporting both this campaign and your own. This appearance is furthered by the juxtaposition of your meetings with NATO, May and your sponsor: Putin.
