Dear Senator Feinstein:

I am concerned about criminal justices. This administration has been hiring political hacks to powerful nonpartisan positions with the most recent example being Judge Kavanaugh. In this case he is also accused of serious crimes including attempted rape and lying to congress. While much of his record remains hidden by his man either in the Bush library or the oval office, a history of lying during confirmation hearings is apparent.
