Dear Mr Vice President:

I am concerned about Presidential incapacity. Section four of the 25th amendment is now looking relevant. The President's incapacity with foreign affairs this week has been striking. Even most evangelical Christians find that abandoning our Kurdish allies to be slaughtered is wrong. Most of the country understands that pressuring foreign governments to smear his opponents is wrong. Federal prosecutors have observed that the sale by Messrs. Parnas and Fruman of his political favors was wrong. The plan to scrap the open skies treaty reminds us of his incapacity to even check with anyone who might understand the effects. Several courts today found him incapable of cobbling together a coherent argument to keep his taxes secret or further torment immigrants. Most glaring however is Mr Cipollone's letter declaring the President's incapacity to obey the constitution.

Please assure me that you will convey to Congress the President's incapacity as per the 25th amendment.

I am very proud to be a US resident and a large part of that derives from our constitutional government.
