The clearest example is your attacks on T visas which were designed for such victims and the resulting significant drop in prosecutions. Revoltingly these victims are being exploited further by you and your daughter who claim to be their champions with a photo event planned tomorrow. Groups actually working against human trafficking such as Freedom Network and Polaris are of course boycotting.

Please assure me that you will increase availability of T-visas.
