Dear Mr President:

I am concerned about vote theft. You are using the postal system to steal ballots. As usual you broadcast your plans well ahead with the appointment of an XPO Logistics board member as Postmaster in June and comments in August that you opposed funding the USPS to block mail-in voting. His attacks significantly slowed the mail even with courts blocking many of the changes. On the electoral end Republicans sued and legislated to make ballots slowed by the USPS ineligible for counting and then as the resulting deadlines loomed Mr DeJoy simply refused an order of District Judge Sullivan to sweep for ballots. Things remain opaque but sufficiently suspicious that pollster Patrick Murray noted vote suppression including by the USPS as a possible source of error in models.

Please assure me that every vote will be counted.

I am very proud to be a US resident and a large part of that derives from our democracy.
